It's been one year since the groundbreaking ceremony for Reimagine Pleasant Street. We have accomplished significant milestones including:

EIGHTH STREET RE-OPENS AHEAD OF SCHEDULE

REIMAGINE Pleasant Street

As you've likely noticed, Eighth Street is open to traffic, and it opened two weeks ahead of schedule. The two new roundabouts will improve traffic flow and safety, making it easier to visit downtown Noblesville. Construction crews constructed the sidewalks and trails along 8th Street, which are helping improve connectivity and walkability in Noblesville, Hamilton County, and beyond when the project is complete in 2025.



CONCRETE POURED FOR NEW BRIDGE

Another major milestone is the bridge deck being poured for the new bridge over the White River. What is a bridge deck? It's the surface cars drive on, so this milestone is a big step in creating another eastwest connection for Noblesville. More than 180 trucks delivered concrete to the site, and 480,000 pounds of rebar was used on the bridge deck. That's the weight of 5 Boeing 737 airplanes!
